We work with over 100 young people each year to increase their wellbeing, build their connection to the community and offer opportunities for the future.

Are you passionate about supporting young refugee girls and women to improve their lives and reach their potential? Do you want to work with people from refugee and diverse backgrounds?

We are looking for a skilled and highly motivated Freelance Project Lead to join our friendly and busy team and take responsibility for the delivery of our <u>Super Girls Project</u>, in Hoxton.

They will be a self-starter, comfortable managing their own time and working to competing deadlines. They will be a natural relationship builder and innovative thinker. The ideal candidate will. They will also be passionate to help young refugee girls and support them to become autonomous and independent young women.

You will be supported in your role by committed volunteers and report directly to the Director of the charity who will support your development in the role. And most importantly, you will be at the heart of an organisation that is a platform for young refugee women to flourish in so many aspects of their lives.



Key Responsibilities

- Managing incoming referrals, liaising with referrers, making initial contact to connect with the young person, and offering appropriate support.
- Maintaining partnerships and outreach efforts with current collaborators and build new partnerships supported by the director and the team.
- Planning and delivery of weekly sessions and monthly local trips
- Ensuring the safeguarding of our young women is the highest priority and following up with all safeguarding concerns
- Ensuring young people's thoughts, ideas and interests are being heard and implemented in the delivery of the project
- Conduct appropriate surveys and monitoring & evaluation sessions on a quarterly basis
- Compiling and completing funders project reports
- Line management of sessional workers and volunteers when needed
- Offering support for young refugee girls through encouraging internal further opportunities or signposting.

- Passion for working with young people from refugee and migrant backgrounds

- Having lived experience of the asylum process in the UK
- Speaking a community language (e.g., Arabic, French, Spanish, Amharic, Tigrinya)
- Experience working with young girls and women & knowledge of the youth sector
- Experience of working in migration/refugee sector
- Knowledge of Gender equality and GBV issues
- Experience working with Non-native English speakers
- Knowledge of and training in safeguarding procedures
